- 5. Suzy Winkler: Thrilled at plan, disappointed of make up of committee, majority not supportive of gas drilling. 53% against drilling**

- 6. Kathy Koch: many growers in town, we rely on the land, think about all the storage and waste water for drilling. Language on drilling needs to be stronger and defined.**

  - 8. Jim Giordano: what is the time frame for the plan? Answered: August, September the latest.**
  - 9. Dawn Slentz: the plan is fine just the way it is.**
